

Electoral Roll Renewal in 2025 - A Message from the Electoral Roll Officer and the PCC

The Electoral Roll (ER) is the register of our Parish's electors. Being on the Church ER is a way of demonstrating your willingness to help shape the future of our Church and the wider Church not just locally, but nationally and even internationally through the election of Deanery or General Synod members. It also enables you to participate and vote in the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM).

Every Parochial Church Council (PCC) is required to maintain an ER and once in every six years, the preparation of new church ER takes place, which means that everyone must come off the roll and re-apply, this is scheduled for 2025 and must take place prior to our APCM.

The Notice of Preparation of New Roll is now posted online and on Noticeboard.
