June Retiring collection is for Village Water Sponsored by Dina Bartle

Village Water is a charity working in Zambia and Mozambique to provide village communities with clean water facilities. They approach each community by giving them sanitation training, and encouraging them to build their own toilets and sinks, as well as providing each community with a clean water well. It also trains up members of the community with the knowledge of how to maintain and repair these wells themselves.

In addition to this, Village Water works with medical Centres in Zambia and Mozambique, ensuring they have wells, medication and a good water supply. The charity also work in schools, building latrine blocks and educating girls about their menstrual cycle (so they don't miss out on their education), including teaching them to make sanitary pads both for their own use and to sell.

By focusing on just these two countries, this small charity is able to be far more effective in its mission to improve sanitation and provide water in Zambia and Mozambique. So, please do support the important work of this charity.
