Pentecost Sunday



The Coming of the Holy Spirit

“And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability” (Acts 2:2-4)

The Day of Pentecost marks fifty days since Easter Day and brings the Easter season to an end. On this day we recall how God's Holy Spirit was poured upon the disciples after Jesus' ascension, empowering them to begin the work of making disciples of all nations. Thus, the day of Pentecost marks beginning of the Church.

The symbols of Pentecost are those of the Holy Spirit and include flames, wind, the breath of God and a dove. Red is the colour most associated with Pentecost, representing the tongues of fire described in Acts of the Apostles, appearing above the heads of the disciples as a sign that they had received the Holy Spirit.
