The Transfiguration

"Jesus took with him Peter and John and James and went up on the mountain to pray. And while he was praying, the appearance of his face changed, and his clothes became dazzling white." – (Luke 9:28 - 29)

9th Sunday of Trinity – Feast of the Transfiguration

The Feast of Transfiguration commemorates the biblical event when Jesus leads three of his disciples, Peter, James, and John, to a mountain where Moses and Elijah appear, and he is 'Transfigured' as his appearance is radiantly transformed. The Transfiguration is one of the miracles of Jesus in the Gospels but unlike others, the miracle happens to Jesus himself.

Transfiguration is a pivotal moment, a powerful demonstration of His divine nature and the manifestation of His glory. The setting on the mountain can be understood as the point where human nature meets God: the meeting place of the temporal and the eternal, with Jesus as the connecting point, acting as the bridge between heaven and earth.
